Two Stonington High School Seniors Recognized for Interest in Environmental Sciences

(August 26, 2024) – The Stonington Garden Club (SGC) announced today that it has awarded scholarships to two Stonington High School (SHS) seniors who will be pursuing studies in Environmental Sciences (ES) in college. The \$1,000 scholarships were presented to Henry Sawin and Ethan King at the SHS Senior Awards night in June.

"More than ever, today's high school students are concerned with environmental issues and the impact of Climate Change. We are proud to offer awards that recognize a focus on the environment and encourage further studies in this critically important field," said Terri Brennan, Chair of the SGC Scholarship Committee.

The Club's history with the ES department at Stonington High School has included providing funds for materials needed for their outdoor gardens, but the Club wanted to do more. Determined to help and encourage local high schoolers, the Club worked closely with the SHS Science Teacher and the officers of the SGC to establish a scholarship award for a graduating senior in the spring of 2017. Now in its eighth year, SGC offers two scholarship awards, an Environmental Studies Award (\$1,000) and an Environmental Awareness Award (\$1,000).

Ethan King – Environmental Awareness Award

Ethan is a bright and personable student who is passionate about the natural world. His career interests include environmental engineering and environmental consulting. As further evidence of his commitment to the environment, he joined the board of the Alliance for the Mystic River Watershed as a student. In his own words, "I have a passion for the environment, and the wellness of the environment around me relates to so much in my everyday life."

Henry Sawin – Environmental Studies Award

Henry plans to be an Environmental Studies major at Middlebury College. He has interests in environmental economics, environmental policy, and environmental psychology, all of which could lead him in the direction of natural resource management and conservation.
